

HOW TO MAKE GRASSHEADS

A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

YOU WILL NEED

- A packet of grass seeds (you'll find these at your local garden centre)
- A pair of stockings
- Potting mix (you can just use some soil from the garden)
- Plastic cup or yoghurt pot or small pot to put your grass head in
- Googly eyes and pipe cleaners/coloured paper to decorate
- Waterproof Glue
- Water



STEP 1 PLANT THE SEEDS

Cut a leg off your stockings and roll it down. Place 2-3 tablespoons of grass seeds in the end of your stocking.

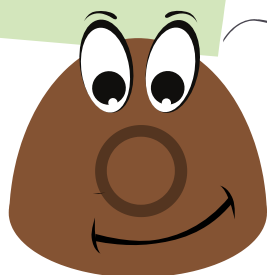
STEP 2

FILL WITH SOIL

Fill the stocking with enough soil to make a ball, roughly the size of a tennis ball. Tie off the stocking so that your soil and seeds are wrapped up tightly.

QUICK TIP

If you want to give your grass head a bulbous nose or big ears, pinch a bit of the stocking and twist to create a small ball and then secure with an elastic band.



STEP 3

FIND A HOME & DECORATE

Find a pot or plastic cup or old jar to put your grass head in. Make sure the seeds are at the top. Now the fun part! You can decorate and add some faces to your stocking! Maybe you can make them look like the members of your family!

STEP 4

FIND THE PERFECT SPOT

Place your Grass Head somewhere where it will get some sunshine, a window ledge works best!

STEP 5

WATER

Don't forget to add water to the pot and the stocking will soak it up. Then it's time to watch your grass hair grow!
